



Access to work areas is only permitted when accompanied by the person in charge or after training has been completed.



It is forbidden to enter the track area.



Smoking ban: For fire safety reasons, smoking on the works premises is permitted only in designated smoking areas.



Do not use the lift in the event of a fire.



Photography and audio recording are only permitted with authorisation.



Touching or operating machinery is prohibited.



Eating in the factory hall area, and in particular the consumption of alcoholic drinks or other intoxicating substances, is prohibited.



Work involving hazardous substances may only be carried out with your coordinator's approval.



Hazardous work (e.g. welding, etc.) is only permitted with a valid permit.



In the event of evacuation signals (e.g. fire alarm) leave the building immediately via the marked escape routes and proceed to the assembly point.



Please wear at least S1 safety work shoes.



Wear the necessary personal protective equipment where required.



Existing traffic routes must be used. Particular care must be taken at hall entrances and exits, as well as at gates and doors. Existing pedestrian entrances and wicket doors must be used. Escape and rescue routes must be kept clear at all times.



Parking is permitted in the designated parking spaces (staff and visitor parking).



Please note that a maximum speed limit of 20 km/h applies throughout the entire factory premises.



The Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) apply at the Chemnitz plant. Vehicle traffic (industrial trucks, lorries, cars, etc.) is to be expected on the plant premises at all times. Rail vehicles always have right of way.



Particular caution is required in the vicinity of pits and working platforms (risk of falling!) and in narrow passages (e.g. gate areas).



Never stand beneath suspended loads. When crane operations are taking place please wait at distance until the crane operator has given the all-clear.



High electrical voltages may be present in some parts of the vehicles and equipment. Do not touch any parts, components or cables. Do not reach into control cabinets.
